1. Course Overview

This programme equips learners with the competencies required to serve as **Advanced Emergency First Aid Responders** in workplace and community environments. It focuses on **risk-based first aid**, enabling learners to assess hazards, implement emergency response plans, and provide advanced life-saving interventions until professional medical assistance arrives.

2. Entry Requirements

- Intermediate Emergency First Aid (NQF Level 3), OR
- Access via Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) demonstrating equivalent competencies.

3. Exit Outcomes

Learners will be able to:

- Assess hazards and risks at an incident scene and ensure safety for first aid provision.
- Provide immediate advanced first aid for life-threatening conditions (trauma or medical emergencies).
- Conduct secondary and ongoing patient assessments to plan and prioritise treatment.
- Treat a wide range of emergencies, including:
- Severe bleeding, shock, burns, fractures, pelvic and spinal injuries.
- Cardiac arrest, heart attack, stroke, seizures, anaphylaxis, diabetic emergencies, asthma attacks.
- Emergency childbirth, drowning, poisoning, thermal/chemical/electrical injuries.
- Coordinate with emergency services and perform professional patient handovers.
- Complete post-incident documentation and restock equipment as per organisational protocols.
